Sophomores that will lead the underclassmen include Emma Daniels, Emily Krause, Anya Binkhoelter, Audrey Quilacio and Grace Abell.




Stockton is a returning state qualifier that will be looking to end his OHS wrestling career with a top-six finish and All-State honors at Mizzou Arena in Columbia.


Michael Martin will lead the list of juniors hitting the mats after his fifth-place finish at 106 pounds in Independence last March
